
900HC032 Mounting Tray

The 900HC032 mounting tray is intended for mounting of Fisher and Paykel Humidifiers such as the HC500 and MR730 and MR850 series. It is designed to prevent the humidifier tipping over accidentally in situations where the humidifier is placed on a table or on the floor. The tray can be configured to be used in conjunction with a variety of home-care ventilation devices, or as a standalone mounting for the humidifier.

WARNING

To prevent accidental water inhalation, the humidifier chamber must always be mounted lower than the patient's head, preferably by at least 400mm. Floor mounted humidifiers must have adult supervision to prevent the patient pulling the humidifier over.

MOUNTING OF HUMIDIFIER ONLY






Figure 1 Mounting of Humidifier only on tray

If a humidifier only is to be mounted, it should be mounted in the center of the tray as shown in figure 1. This configuration provides maximum stability, and is suitable for when the humidifier is placed on the floor and used with infants who can walk or crawl.

To prevent the humidifier being pulled out of the mounting shaft, the humidifier can be locked in place by tightening up the screw in the back of the mounting shaft in figure 2 (use Allen key provided).

MOUNTING OF WATER BAG POLES

When using an autofeed chamber such as the Fisher and Paykel MR290, a waterbag pole (eg. Fisher and Paykel ref. 900MR290) can be screwed in to the top of the humidifier mounting shaft, see figure 2.

CAUTION: Do not use a water bag with a capacity of greater than 1 litre (1000ml)

MOUNTING OF HUMIDIFIER AND OTHER EQUIPMENT TOGETHER

When using a humidifier and another device such as a non-invasive ventilator or CPAP blower, both devices can be mounted on the tray to give added stability. (See figure 3).



MOUNTING A PULMONETICS SYSTEMS VENTILATOR

When using a Pulmonetics Systems ventilator, the humidifier can be mounted alongside the ventilator on the 900HC032 tray, see figure 4. Use the velcro strips provided to fix the ventilator holder to the mounting tray. (See also Pulmonetics mounting instructions).


